



# STATEMENT REGARDING 2021 CAMP SESSIONS

*Churches, ministries, and families around the world have been affected by health concerns and government regulations over the past year. At Camp Niangua, the health and safety of our campers and sponsors is of utmost importance. As we have monitored the changing circumstances impacting our communities in planning for the upcoming Camp season, we have implemented the following policies in an effort to address continuing health concerns.*

1. We are requesting that churches pre-register for camp as soon as possible. This helps us to manage staffing, cleaning, and room assignments prior to the arrival of campers.

2. We request that Sponsors check the temperature of each camper and sponsor **prior** to leaving for camp. In addition, each person arriving at camp will be checked for fever upon arrival. Any individual with a fever (measured as 100.4 degrees according to CDC guidelines) will not be allowed to attend, nor will the campers who rode in the same vehicle with that individual. Transportation for any individual who is not allowed to remain at camp shall be the responsibility of the sponsoring church.
3. Any individual who experiences symptoms thought to indicate COVID-19, shall immediately present to on-site nursing staff for evaluation.
4. We encourage each sponsor to bring hand sanitizer for use in rooms and throughout the day. In addition, multiple sanitizer dispensers will be placed in common areas. Please encourage proper hand washing and appropriate social distancing in addition to the use of hand sanitizer.
5. We encourage minimizing physical contact (hugs, handshakes, fist bumps, etc.), instead opting for creative means of greeting while maintaining distance.
6. While we appreciate the love and support, we are asking that no visitors attend daily activities or evening services in order to minimize contacts.
